Charles River hosts second annual Eureka Science Fair

Charles River's is hosting its second annual student science competition, the Eureka Science Fair, for the children and young relatives of their employees. The Eureka Science Fair is an opportunity for children to learn about the world of biomedical research and be inspired by science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) by designing their own experiments. The theme of the event is "Together, We Build Healthier Lives."

The Science Fair competition, which aims to nurture an interest in science by allowing students to design their own experiments, includes two age categories: 10-13 and 14-18. Students can submit projects in their native language, and entries can include more than one child (last year, three siblings submitted a nifty "weather" demonstration). Prizes will be awarded in each age group. The Eureka Science Fair has a focus on projects that show how we can make a difference in improving health.

Along with the science project competition, Charles River is also offering, for the second year, a wide range of 20-minute webinars presented by our own researchers. Children can tune in online and learn about science careers, nature, bacteria, viruses, the brain, what causes allergies, how drugs are made and many other exciting topics. As Charles River is a global organisation, the webinars will be offered in multiple languages.
